Early has signed to play next year at Furman University. **Rhodis Eason** (6' 3, Forward, 2012) is a well rounded inside-out player who presents a difficult matchup. **Armand Jackson** (6' 5, Forward, 2011) is an athletic and physically strong power player. Senior floor general **Brandon Clark** will run the show from the lead guard position.
